



Farming Minister Launches New Water Management Tool

A new Water Management Tool, developed by leading farming charity, LEAF (Linking Environment And Farming), will be launched by Jim Paice MP, Minister of State for Agriculture and Food.

Mr Paice will unveil LEAF's latest management tool at their annual President's Event on the 2nd November. The easy to use, on-line resource offers farmers a complete health check for water use on their farm, helping to make every drop count. Split into 7 sections, it looks at better distribution and monitoring; improved irrigation; more efficient washing systems; protecting water quality; recycling and reuse. Using the tool, farmers will be able to better understand how to increase their efficiency and, in turn, make significant savings on their water bills.

Speaking on the new resource, Mr Paice said:

"Farmers need to meet the enormous challenge of producing almost 50 per cent more food by 2030. But alongside these pressures, urbanization, industrialization and climate change are all increasing the demands on limited water supplies. So to improve its water use and efficiency, agriculture will need to use innovative new methods such as LEAF's Water Management Tool."
